




A pattern is something that repeats in a specific order.

Where is the pattern here? Do you see the crosswalk and it's pattern of white, black, white, black lines?




This leaf has a pattern! There is the leaf, vein, leaf, vein all of the way up the stem.




This is a bicycle rack. See how its shape goes up, down, up, down? That's a pattern!

This barber shop painted this great pattern outside of its door. This painted chevron pattern is blue, white, red, blue, white, red.



Patterns can be in a circle too! This manhole cover has a round and round pattern of large and small hexagons.
