


Our Return to the Garden

Last time we looked at the train tracks. This time a train went by! Two more went by on our way back to school. We waved and the driver tooted his horn!






Last time the tree was bare in front of the blue house. It is full of green leaves now.

We thought these were lilies last time. Now that they have bloomed, we know they are irises.












We found many newly bloomed flowers on our walk. There were pretty purple, pink and white flowers.
