

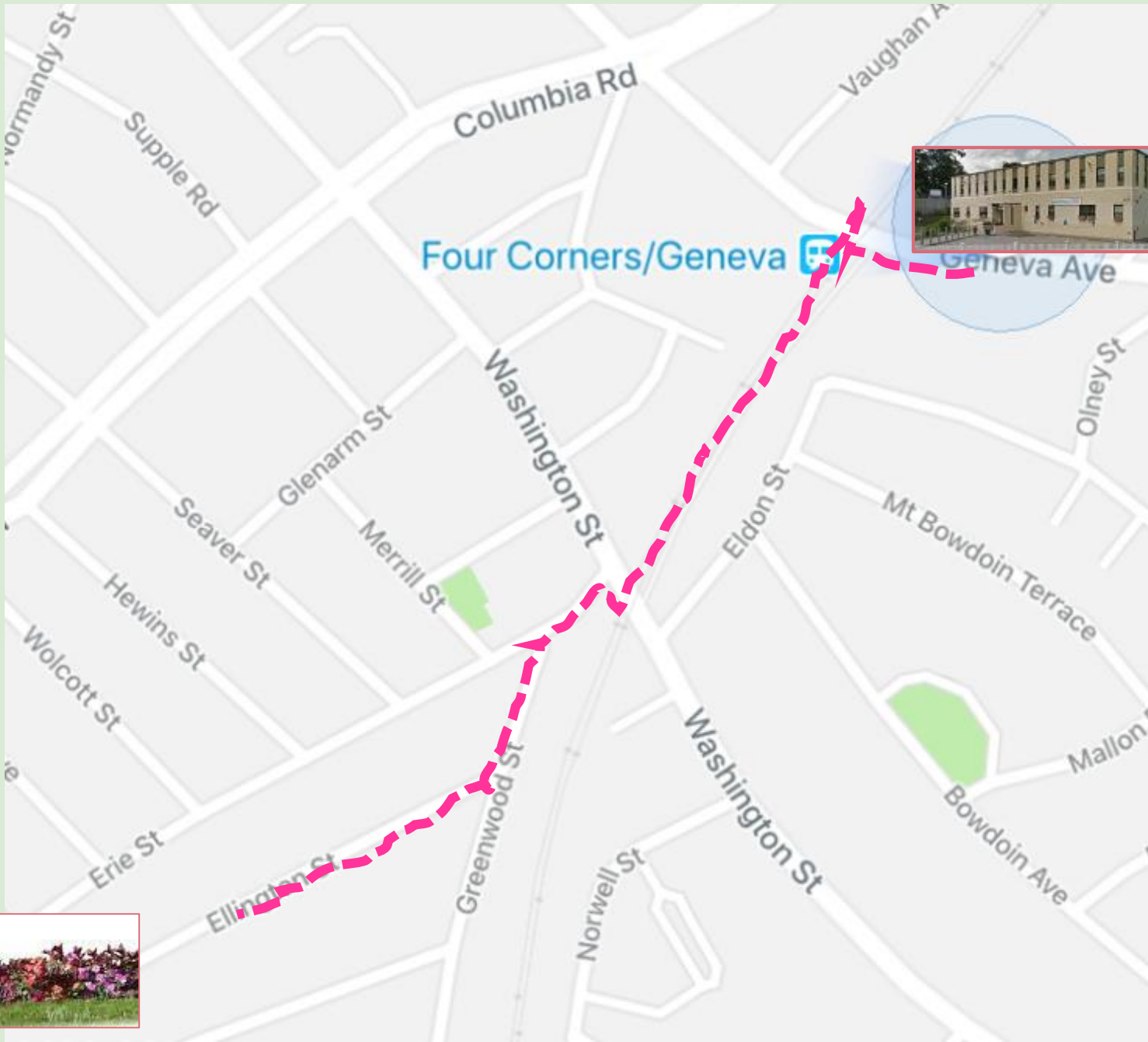


Our Walk to a Garden

these lilies be?



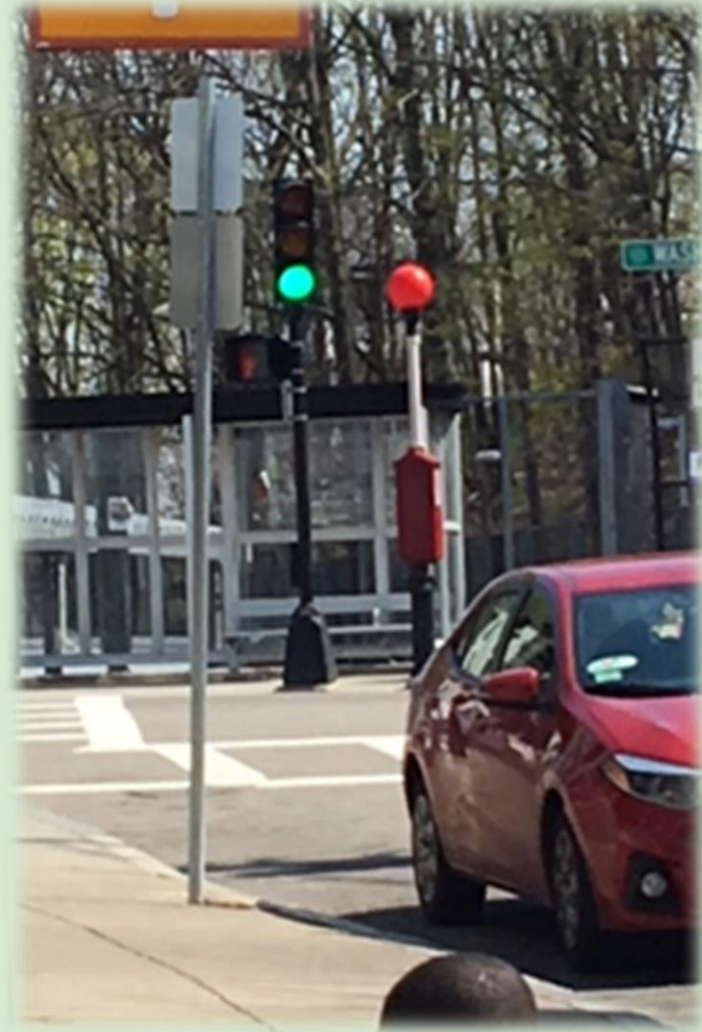
We looked for a fire hydrant and the black fence. We turned here to head back to school.

Look! We can see our school!



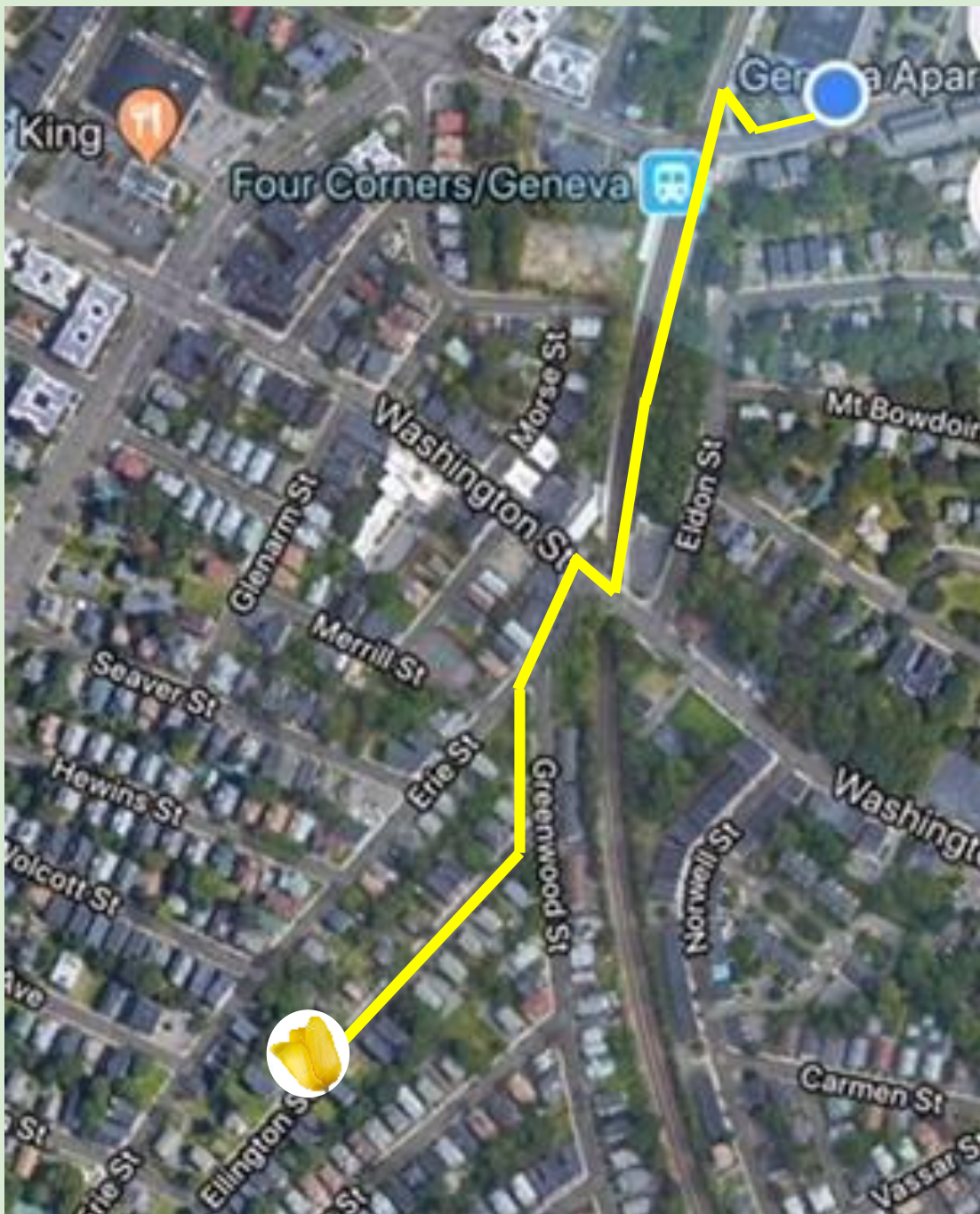
When we made it to the platform, we remembered to walk away from the yellow line for safety. We found the opening off of the platform and headed down the ramp.
